This world-class facility is located on a 10-acre site and employs 65 people. The plant manufactures components for the polyurethane industry including prepolymers and catalysts. We expect the plant tour to be concluded within 1 hour.

Following the tour, we will convene at 6pm at nearby Gervasi's Restaurant for a full Italian Buffet. Entrees include stuffed shells, meatballs, chicken, salad, vegetable, and non-alcoholic beverages. There will be a cash bar. The cost per person will be \$20.

The Air Products Paulsboro plant is located at 675 Billingsport Road in Paulsboro, NJ. Directions to the plant can be found on MapQuest. Take 95-S to the Commodore Barry Bridge. Cross bridge and follow 295-N toward Camden (2nd right after bridge) to exit 16A (Paulsboro/Swedesboro). At end of ramp, turn right and follow for approximately two miles (you will go straight through one blinking caution light and two traffic lights). After second traffic light you will see Mobil Lube plant on right and Mobil Refinery on left. APCI will be on right after second set of RR tracks. (Look for green and white fence).

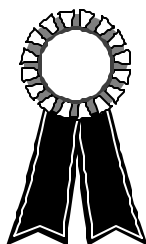

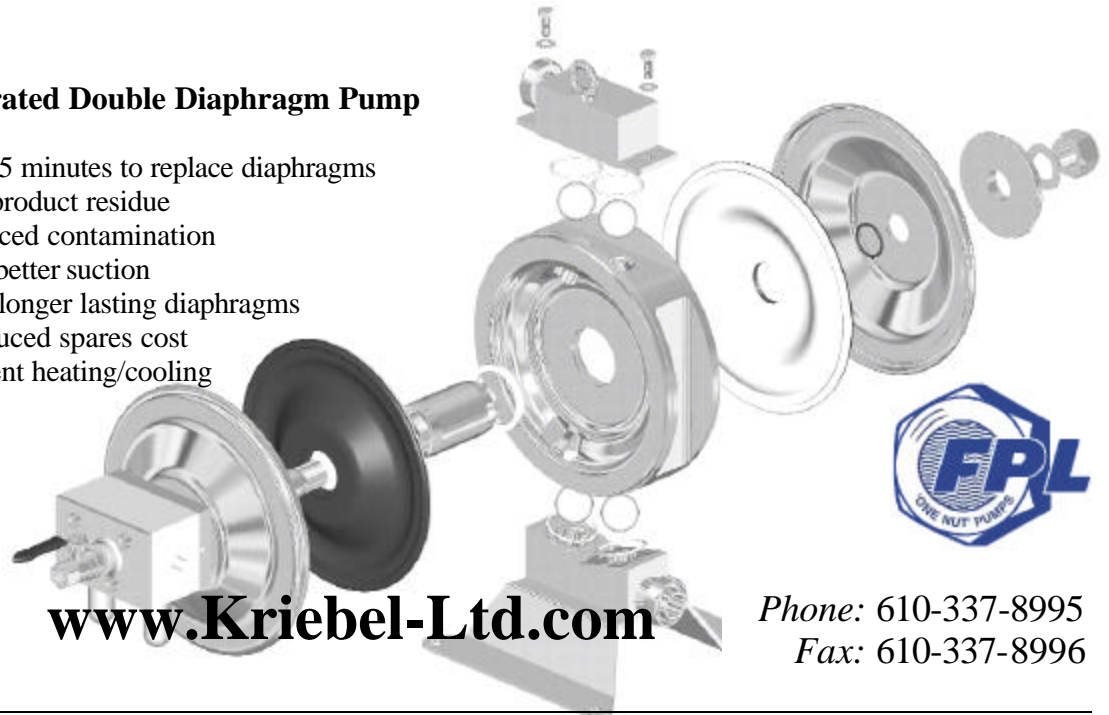
